Ruby's Place 2016-2017 Fiscal Year Annual Report

Founded in 1972 by a group of concerned citizens, **Ruby's Place** proudly celebrates its **45th year of service** in 2017. We are California's first incorporated shelter for victims of domestic violence and the first shelter in Alameda County to provide emergency services to survivors of human trafficking.

Ruby's Place 24-Hour Crisis Hotline received **over 2500 calls** last year. The Hotline is staffed with trained domestic violence counselors available any time of the day or night to offer emotional support, referrals and crisis intervention.

Ruby's Place Counseling services were offered individually at semi-weekly drop-in support groups and during group sessions. Staff Counselors provided **900 individual sessions**.

Ruby's Place Children's Program includes clinicians and professionals who work closely with children and their caregivers to heal the traumatic effects of living with violence. **Over 100 family therapy sessions and 85 one-on-one parent education sessions** were provided by our clinicians, which helps mothers and families develop appropriate skills and techniques to cope

with crisis and heal from trauma.

Ruby's Place provides the highest propriety to police departments and hospitals who contact us for victims in need of shelter of services. Last year more than **80 calls** came from local law enforcement and hospitals.

Ruby's Place 42 bed shelter provided **12,192 bed nights** last year for women and children seeking refuge from domestic violence or human trafficking.

"In 2016 victims made 1,083 requests for service-including emergency shelter, childcare, legal representation and more that could not be provided as programs did not have the resources for these services..."

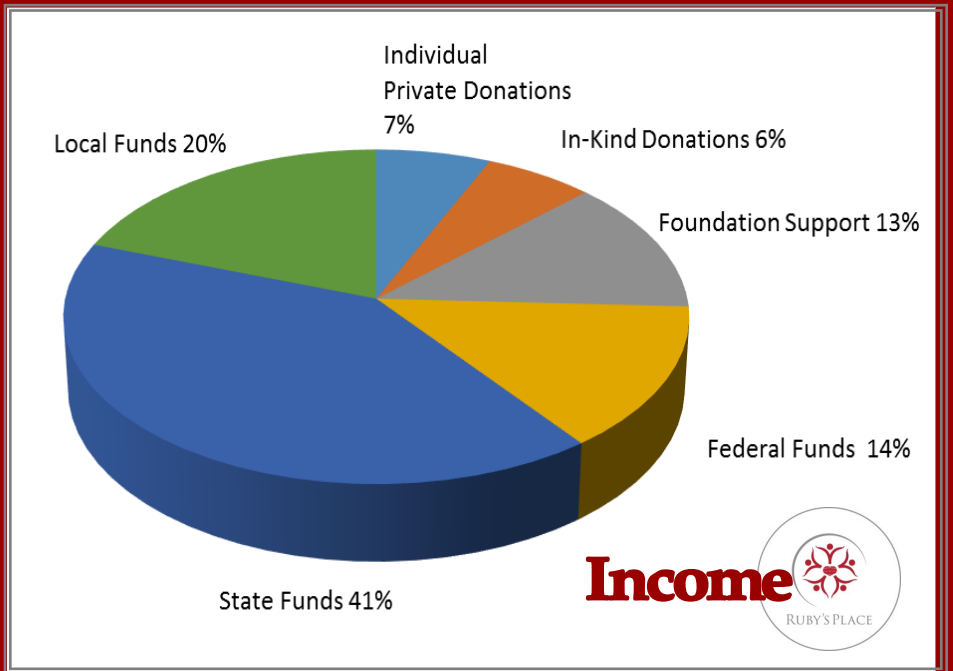

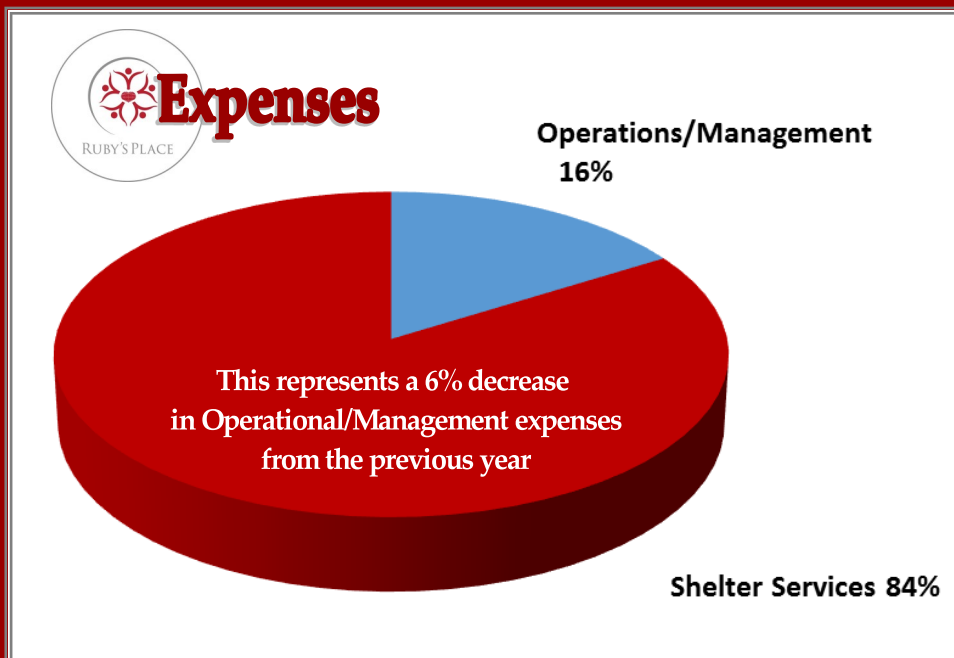
